Privacy Statement

About us:

AFL Ireland is the governing body for Australian Rules Football in Ireland. AFL Ireland is affiliated to AFL Europe, and in turn to AFL, the world governing body for the sport.

What data we will collect:

In becoming a member of AFL Ireland, certain information about you will be collected which will include your name, date of birth, gender, email address, address, telephone number, names of the AFL Ireland affiliated clubs that you are a member of and details of any coaching or officiating licenses you hold (all referred to as **AFL Data**). We will also collect the full name and telephone number of the emergency contact(s) nominated by you, as well as details of injuries or medical conditions as provided by you. You may also choose to provide us with other information.

Why we will collect it:

We will collect and process your AFL Data for the purposes of registering you as a member of AFL Ireland and administering your involvement in the sport. We will process it on the basis of legitimate interests. The legitimate interests are the interests of registering you as a member and to administer the sport. We will only use your AFL Data for the purposes of registering and administering your involvement in the sport.

How long we will keep it:

We will retain your AFL Data for such time as you are registered with us and will then delete your information on a staged basis as follows:

Type of Data	When Deleted
Name, date of birth, gender, email address, address, telephone number, names of the AFL Ireland affiliated clubs that you are a member of and details of any coaching or officiating licenses you hold	Three years after an individual has not played an active part in AFL
Data on any injuries, medical conditions etc. as provided by you	On the receipt of a new annual membership form or six years as per insurance requirements
Membership forms	Three years after an individual has not played an active part in AFL
Vetting data and application forms	Four years after the receipt of a vetting application on its expiry
Competition results, Team sheets, Training attendance lists	Indefinite as a record of club sporting results (personal details other than name and event are deleted after three years)
Competition Officials - Name, date of birth, gender, email address, address, telephone number	One year- yearly re-subscription.

Sharing your data:

We may share your AFL Data with other AFL organisations for the purposes of your competition and event participation. We may share your AFL Data with partners and third-party data managers that we appoint as data processors as part of administering your involvement in sport. We will not transfer your data to any other third parties without obtaining your consent and, where possible, will anonymise your data before sharing. We will not share any other personal data you provide to us that is not AFL Data.
